HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 253, L.D. 722, Bill, "AN ACT to Further Exempt Certain Benevolent Organizations from the Employment Security Law."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Manpower Affairs estimates that, if this bill had been in effect during 1980, \leftarrow a decrease in contributions \rightarrow of \$6,000 would have resulted. Benefit costs may also be reduced slightly by this proposal since these wages would not be considered subject, ^{to} employment and, therefore, would not appear in a claimant's base period. This would tend to reduce benefits paid to these individuals, but it is believed that the reduction would be nominal to their dedicated revenue account.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
