COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 637, L.D. 727, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning the Suspension of a Drivers License for  
Operating a Motor Vehicle under the Influence of Alcohol  
or Refusing to Submit to a Blood or Breath Analysis."

Amend the Bill by striking out at the beginning of the  
first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation  
and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of sections  
2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment retains the requirement that the written  
statement that a person refused to submit to a blood or  
breath test under the operating under the influence statutes  
be sent to the Secretary of State within 72 hours rather than  
within the 20/<sup>days</sup> provided for under current law. The amendment  
deletes the sections of the bill which raised the minimum  
period of license suspension for a first operating under  
the influence conviction from 30 days to 60 days and which  
changed the conditions under which the Secretary of State may  
issue a restricted license.
