IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing and Directing the Board of Pesticides Control to Study and Report on Urban Pesticide Usage.

Urban pesticide usage; study and report. Resolved: That the Board of Pesticides Control is authorized to study and directed to report to the Legislature on the use, in urban areas, of chemical insecticides, fungicides, herbicides and other chemical pesticides subject to the jurisdiction of the board; and be it further

Resolved: That this report, and any accompanying suggestions for legislation, be submitted in final form to the first regular session of the 111th Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the Board of Pesticides Control to study the use of pesticides in urban areas and to report back to the first regular session of the 111th Legislature.
