COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to S.P. 264, L.D. 746, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Standards of the Maine Land Use Regula-
tion Commission."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§8, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1977,
c. 327, §2, is amended to read:

Amendments to land use standards so adopted shall ~~be effective~~
~~immediately-but-shall-be-submitted-to-the-next-regular-or~~
~~special-session-of-the-Legislature-for-approval-or-modification-~~
~~if-the-Legislature-fails-to-act,-such-standards-shall~~
~~continue-in-full-force-and-effect~~ expire 90 days after the
adjournment of the next regular session of the Legislature
unless approved by legislative resolve.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the Legislature to approve
land
amendments to L U R C / use standards by legislative resolve.
