COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 265, L.D. 747, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to State Participation in Local Leeway under the School Finance Act."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the bill ^{after the amending clause} /in paragraph A by inserting at the end the following new sentence:

'Notwithstanding ~~section 4747, subsection 6,~~ section 4747, subsection 6, for the year 1981-82, the state's computed obligation for this program shall be limited by the amount allocated by the Legislature as the state's share of local leeway.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the State to fund the proposed increase in leeway payments from the unexpended balance in that account and removes the emergency preamble and the emergency clause.
