AN ACT Concerning Meetings of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 151-A is enacted to read:

§ 151-A. First meeting after election

At the first meeting of the commissioners after a general election the only item of business may be the election or designation of a chairman.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill limits the business that may be conducted by county commissioners at the first meeting after a general election to the election or designation of a chairman.
