HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655,  
L.D. 758, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for  
Substitute Teachers."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end, before the  
statement of fact, the following:

'Fiscal Note

Because of the 2-year lag in the state subsidy for  
education, this bill will not have an impact on state funds  
until fiscal year 1983-84. While it is difficult to estimate  
the impact in 1983-84, based on the maintenance of the current  
state subsidy ratio and based on an estimated current average  
remuneration of \$25 per day, the best estimate of costs to the  
State would be \$135,000 in 1983-84. The total yearly cost  
reflection in the State and local allocation is estimated at  
\$251,000.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
