COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655, L.D. 758, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Substitute Teachers."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §1901, 3rd ¶, as repealed and replaced by
PL 1967, c. 462, is amended to read:

Substitute teachers with 4 years of study beyond the
high school and with a bachelor's degree and in possession
of a standard teachers' certificate and substitute teachers
who have retired after a minimum of 15 years teaching shall
be compensated at the rate of not less than \$20 \$30 for each
day of service.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment increases the minimum salary for substitute
teachers from \$20 to \$30. The state minimum wage is \$3.35
per hour or \$26.80 for 8 hours.
