STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Exempt Wood Splitters from Special Equipment Registration Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 242-A, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 127, § 165, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

No registration is required of a wood splitter when the same is used for private noncommercial purposes and highway use is limited to travel from or to the premises where kept or between locations where used or to and from a business location for repairs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts private noncommercial wood splitters from registration requirements, for limited highway use.
