COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 274, L.D. 783, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Application of Military Service Credits to Retirement Benefits for Employees of Local Districts under the Maine State Retirement System."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'5 MRSA §1094, sub-§13, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 622, §§35 and 36, is further amended by inserting after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

A local district may elect, with regard to special retirement plans under section 1092, subsection 3 and section 1121, subsections 4, 8 and 9, that military service credits under this subsection shall only apply to additional retirement benefits under section 1092, subsection 3-A and shall not apply to age or service requirements of retirement.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Military Service Credits under the special Fire and Police Plan for local districts would not be applied to the age and service requirements

for retirement. This amendment would only apply to local districts which elect it as an option.
