IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for Maintenance of the Dead River Dam.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

These funds are to be used for the care and maintenance of the Dead River Dam in Leeds.

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate \$1,250 for the 1981-82 fiscal year to be used for the care and maintenance of the Dead River Dam in Leeds, which is the only state-constructed and state-owned dam.
