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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

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**AN ACT to Remove the 10-mile Radius Restriction on Location of Agency Stores under the Liquor Laws.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 153, first ¶, last 2 sentences, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 117, § 1, are repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove the 10-mile radius restriction on licensing an agency store located near a state store or another agency store.
