COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 688, L.D. 802, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the State Valuation of the Town of Easton."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in its place the following:

'AN ACT Relating to Funding of Easton Schools for 1981.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
title and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as
emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of Easton needs to receive all school funding
prior to October, 1981; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Special grant for school funding. Notwithstanding any provision
of statute to the contrary, the state allocation for general purpose
aid shall be increased by \$13,602 and the state share of local leeway
shall be increased by \$1,844 for the Town of Easton for the 1981-82
year of distribution only.
