STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prohibit the Sale of Kegs of Malt Liquor to Nonlicense Holders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 757, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 125, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§ 757. **Malt liquor sales in kegs**

Malt liquor in kegs shall not be sold to any person who is not licensed under this Title.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would prohibit the sale of beer in kegs to anyone not licensed by the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.
