COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " S.P. 302, L.D. 846, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Vehicle Sizes and Weights."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause  
the following:

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §246, as <sup>last</sup> amended by PL 1979, c. 439, §11,  
is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new  
paragraph to read:

A registration fee of \$27 shall be paid for each thousand  
pounds or portion thereof of gross weight a vehicle is registered  
for in excess of 80,000 pounds.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, after the amending/ in the  
4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure  
"100,000" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '90,000'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, last line (2nd line from  
end in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "100,000" and  
inserting in its place the underlined figure '90,000'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to read  
consecutively.

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the statement  
of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

Two thousand seventy-seven trucks are registered  
in the State for 80,000 pounds gross weight. There is  
no estimate on how many would register for weights between  
80,001 and 90,000 pounds. The maximum revenue, if 2077 trucks are  
registered for 90,000 pounds, would be \$560,790.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the weight provided in the bill  $\longleftrightarrow$  and provide for additional registration fee for 1,000 pounds in excess of 80,000 pounds now allowed by law.
