SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 303,
L.D. 847, Bill, "AN ACT Promoting the Availability of Health
Care Services."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last
underlined paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting
in its place the following:

'The Department of Human Services or its agent may not
impose any regulatory policy that effects the registration and
licensing of health care professionals by reason of number or
location, except that nothing in this section shall diminish
the requirements of the National Health Planning and Resources
Development Act of 1974, as amended; the requirements of the
Maine Certificate of Need Act of 1978, as amended; the provisions
of any municipal zoning ordinance; or any contract entered into
by a health care professional or by a participant in the post-
graduate health professional program.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the scope of the
committee amendment to the Department of Human Services or its
agents.
