COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 303, L.D. 847, Bill "AN ACT Promoting the Availability of Health Care Services."

Amend the Bill by striking out the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

'No governmental, quasi-governmental or private regulatory agency or organization may impose any administrative rule, regulatory policy, planning guideline or similar directive which shall or may have the effect of restricting the registration and licensing of health care professionals by reason of number, location or special ty training, except that nothing in this section shall diminish the requirements of the National Health Planning and Resources Development Act of 1974, as amended; the requirements of the Maine Certificate of Need Act/ of 1978, as amended; the provisions of any municipal zoning ordinance; or any contract entered into by a health care professional or by a participant in the post-graduate health profession program.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects a reference to the title of a Federal Act, and exempts from the bill's application the/

the provisions of any municipal zoning ordinance and contracts such as those entered into by participants in the medical education program.
