STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Extend the Manager's Position at Popham Beach State Park in Phippsburg from a 9-month Part-time to a 12-month Full-time Position.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 602, sub-§ 5, as amended by PL 1973, c. 460, § 19, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The bureau shall appoint a manager for Popham Beach State Park in Phippsburg to act on a year-round, full-time basis.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes the manager's position at Popham Beach State Park on a year-round, full-time basis.
