STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require that Energy Conservation Courses be Taught in Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 1286-A is enacted to read:

§ 1286-A. Energy conservation

Every administrative unit shall provide for a course of study in secondary schools which provides students with a fundamental background in energy conservation to encourage the maximum efficient utilization of natural energy resources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires school administrative units to provide, in the secondary schools, a course in energy conservation.
