COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 740, L.D. 878, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Limitation on Damages for Loss of Comfort, Society and Companionship in Wrongful Death Actions."

Amend the Bill after the amending clause in the 8th and 9th lines (6th line in L.D.) by striking out the striken out words and figure "~~not-exceeding-\$10,000~~" and inserting in their place the following: 'not exceeding ~~¢10,000~~ \$50,000'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the limit on the amount of damages from \$10,000 to \$50,000. The original bill proposed removing the limit entirely.
