IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning the Sale of Certain Off Road Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSa § 1952-B is enacted to read:

§ 1952-B. Sales of special equipment

The seller of any special mobile equipment, as defined in Title 29, section 1, subsection 14, shall send a copy of the bill of sale to the municipality where the buyer resides, if the sale price exceeds \$10,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires sellers of special mobile equipment, such as bulldozers, to mail a copy of the bill of sale to the municipality where the buyer resides, if the sale price exceeds \$10,000.
