STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to Provide Reimbursement for Parking Costs Incurred by Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA § 1215, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 391, § 1, is amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

A juror shall be reimbursed for all parking expenses incurred by that juror during required attendance at sessions of the court.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
