HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 322, L.D. 912, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Rangeley Water
District."

Amend the Amendment on page 2 by inserting after the
3rd paragraph the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 13.'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the Following:

'Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.'

Statement of Fact

Section 13 of the bill is unnecessary because the property
of the district which is within the district, as a quasi-
municipal corporation, is already exempt from property taxation
under Title 36, section 651. This change will not require
50% reimbursement under the provisions of the Constitution of
Maine.
