L. D. 914, Bill, "AN ACT to Create an Environmental Health Program."

Amend the amendment by inserting before the last paragraph
before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Expenditure funds. The funds appropriated for
personal services under this program in the biennium shall be
expended for 2 professional positions and one clerical position.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
