COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 804, L.D. 914, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Create an Environmental Health Program."

Amend the Bill by striking out the emergency preamble.

Further amend the Bill in section 1, in that part designated "§1692." in subsection 4, by inserting after the underlined words "Departments of" the underlined word and punctuation 'Conservation,'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, in that part designated '§1693.', by striking out in the first line the underlined word "Avisory" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'Advisory'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, in that part designated "§1694." in the 5th and 6th lines (3rd and 4th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "educational research eleemosynary" and inserting in their place the following underlined words and punctuation 'educational, research and eleemosynary'

Further amend the Bill by striking out the emergency clause.

Statement of Fact

The removal of the emergency preamble and emergency clause means that the bill will go into effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature. The later effective date means that the cost of the bill, appropriated for in the Governor's Part II budget, will be less; salaries will be paid for only 3/4 of the 1981-82 fiscal year and there will be a corresponding decline in the All Other account for rent and other expenses. The estimate of the expected

savings is \$22,187.
