COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 773, L.D. 918, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Law Relating to Foreclosure Proceedings
by Civil Action."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 4.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the proposal to limit deficiencies in the case of purchases by mortgagees at public sale of owner-occupied single family residences only. Deficiencies should be limited in all cases of purchases by mortgagees at public sale as in current law.
