SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 786, L.D. 931, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Trucks Carrying Explosive Material to Come to a Complete Stop Before Crossing Railroad Tracks."

Amend the Amendment in the 2nd paragraph, last 2 lines by striking out the underlined words "railroad track" and inserting in its place the following underlined words 'unattended or unautomated railroad grade crossing'

Further amend the Amendment in the 3rd paragraph in the next to the last line by striking out the underlined words "on that track"

Further amend the Amendment in the 3rd paragraph in the last line by striking out the underlined words "onto or across the track" and inserting in their place the following underlined words 'over the crossing'

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the responsibility of the operator to stop the truck or trailer to those railroad grade crossings which are unattended or which have no automatic crossing gates. Also, the amendment makes the reference to crossings consistent throughout.
