SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 766,
L.D. 936, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Duties of the Register of
Deeds."

Amend the amendment by inserting before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 5, 6, 7 and 8. $^{\prime}$

Further amend the amendment by striking out at the beginning of the first paragraph the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 26 and 27°

Statement of Fact

This amendment:

1. Deletes sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the bill, thus maintaining the present requirement that certificates of organization of corporations be recorded in the county registry of deeds;

- Deletes a requirement in the bill that signers of a deed have their name typed or printed under their signatures;
- 3. Deletes section 27 of the bill which will preserve newlythe present law that a / recorded deed be entered on the day books of the registry within one hour of the time it is recorded.
