STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Residing Prior to Voting in an Election.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 241, sub-§ 3, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 414, § 7, is amended to read:

3. **Residence.** In order to vote in any election, he shall have established a residence in this State and in the municipality in which he resides for 30 days next prior to the election.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes a 30-day residency requirement for voters.
