COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 798, L.D. 952, Bill, "AN ACT Equalizing the Retail Price of Alcoholic Beverages Throughout the State to that of the Kittery Store."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

An estimate of the actual loss of revenue from enactment of this bill is not possible. < > the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages estimates that the net revenue to the General Fund for 1982-83 would be considerably less than now estimated. A computerized analysis reflects that should sales for 1979-80 have been at Kittery prices, the net revenue to the General Fund would have been reduced by \$9,933,990. In order to offset this loss, it would be necessary to realize a 36% increase in sales.

Part of the repealed language provided that certain licensees, entitled under Title 28, section 204 to purchase at a discount, would not receive a further discount by operation of the retail discount at Kittery.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
