HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 798, L.D. 952, Bill, "AN
ACT Equalizing the Retail Price of Alcoholic Beverages
Throughout the State to that of the Kittery Store."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of
Fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Repeal. This Act is repealed on July 1, 1984,
the
and on that date, that portion of Revised Statutes, Title 28,
section 451, repealed by this Act, is reenacted to read as it
did prior to the effective date of this Act.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a sunset provision
to the bill so that the equalization of prices will be given a
1-year trial period.
