IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

**AN ACT Relating to the Registration of Boat, Camper and Utility Trailers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 106, first ¶, first sentence**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 664, is amended to read:

The registration year for all vehicles, except automobiles, newly acquired motor trucks ~~and~~, truck tractors ~~and boat, camper and utility trailers~~, is from March 1st to the last day of February of the next calendar year.

**Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 106, sub-§ 4** is enacted to read:

**4. Trailers. The registration for any boat, camper or utility trailer expires on the last day of the month, 3 years from the month of issuance.**

**Sec. 3. 29 MRSA § 244, first ¶**, as amended by PL 1965, c. 18, § 1, is further amended to read:

The ~~annual~~ fees for the registration of trailers and camp trailers shall be in accordance with this section and shall accompany the application for registration.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for the registration of boat, camper and utility trailers every 3 years rather than annually.
