COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 351, L.D. 994, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require that Legislators Include in their Ethic
Reports Whether they are Union Members and Pay Union Dues
During the Year."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1016-A." in
the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined
word "Representatives" the following: ', whose primary source
of income is negotiated for by a union,'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§1016-A."
in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by inserting after the
underlined word "unions" the following: ', by which he is
represented,'

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the reporting requirement to
Legislators whose primary source of income is negotiated for
by a union by which he is represented.
