STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require that Legislators Include in their Ethic Reports Whether they are Union Members and Pay Union Dues During the Year.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 1016-A is enacted to read:

§ 1016-A. Statement of membership in labor organizations

Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall also file a statement listing the labor organizations and labor unions of which he was a member during the preceding calendar year and to which he paid dues. This statement shall be filed with the commission prior to the close of the 2nd week in February of each year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require Legislators to include in their ethic reports a list of labor organizations and labor unions to which they belong and pay dues.
