COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 893, L.D. 997, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Availability of Municipal Ordinances."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Availability. Each ordinance shall be on file with the municipal clerk and shall be accessible to any member of the public. Copies shall be made available to any member of the public, at reasonable cost, at the expense of the person making the request. Notice of availability of the ordinance shall be posted.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that ordinances shall be on file with the municipal clerk and not with some other individual. It also deletes the word "easily" from the phrase "easily accessible."
