HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 999, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Truck Volume Labeling for Certain Wood By-Products."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'A carrier transporting loose sawdust or wood shavings for final delivery to a destination where <sup>they</sup> will be used in the production of agricultural commodities shall conspicuously label the volume capacity of the vehicle in cubic feet or cords. For the purposes of this section, a cord means 128 cubic feet.

Any sale from a vehicle covered by this section shall be accompanied by a sales slip indicating the volume sold.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the carrier to be labeled in cubic feet or cubic cords, rather than cubic yards.
