SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 839, L.D. 1005, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Equivalent Courses Offered at the Various Campuses of the University of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

It is estimated by a member of the board of trustees, that approximately \$148,000 would be needed to implement the provisions of the bill. Costs would be generated by ~~the~~ organization and work of the committee, a review of present academic programs, analysis of university-wide records, the replacement, revision and duplication of records and materials and other costs.'
