COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 877, L.D. 1046, Bill,
"AN ACT to Permit Persons 15 Years of Age and Older to Work
until 10 P.M."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'26 MRSA §774, 3rd ¶ is amended to read:

No minor under ~~16~~ 15 years of age shall be employed
between the hours of 9 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the restriction preventing minors
15 years of age from working after certain hours. Under the
amendment, minors under 15 years of age could work until 10
p.m., rather than 9 p.m., and there is no restriction on which
hours a minor of 15 or older could be employed.
