HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 877, L.D. 1046, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Persons 15 Years of Age and Older to Work until 10 P.M."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'No minors under ~~16~~ 15 years of age shall be employed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. and no minor 15 years of age who has not yet attained his 16th birthday may be employed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment retains the purpose of the original bill, namely, to allow persons 15 years of age to work until 10 p.m. without affecting the ability which exists under present law for minors age 16 and older to work at other hours.
