COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 887, L.D. 1056,
 Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Land Conveyed by the State to the
 Town of Bridgton."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by inserting at the end
 the following:

'All revenues received by the Town of Bridgton from the sale
 of currently developed and leased portions of the parcel
 described in section 1 of /shall be held in a reserve fund for
 use by the town as follows: Principal of the fund for
 acquisition and development of other public lands of the town
 to provide for public access and use; and income of the fund
 for maintenance of park and recreational property of the
 town. The portion of the parcel described in section 1/ not
 currently developed and leased and not sold by the town
 under this/^{Act,} shall be retained by the town for public use.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes conditions for use of the
 land and of proceeds from sale of the land.
