STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Include the Cost of Child Care or Day Care under the Laws Covering Reimbursement of Expenses to Citizens Serving on Boards and Commissions of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 20 is enacted to read:
- § 20. Child care or day care expenses

Members of any board or commission who are authorized by law to be reimbursed for expenses while serving on such a board or commission shall receive necessary expenses for child care or day care services during the time when the members are engaged in the business of the board or commission.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide reimbursement for child care and day care expenses to members serving on state boards and commissions.
