Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the next to the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

to this section, a copy of the proposed rule shall be sent to
the legislative committee having
jurisdiction over health and institutional services.

A copy of any rule adopted by the bureau shall be submitted to
the same committee. The committee may review the rule and
if it determines that it should be stricken or amended, the
committee may prepare legislation to accomplish that purpose

'3. Legislative review. When a rule is proposed pursuant

The rule shall remain in effect unless the full Legislature acts to strike or amend it, or it is repealed or amended by the bureau in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure

Act, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II.'

and submit that legislation to the full Legislature in accordance

with the legislative rules.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment amends the committee amendment by requiring that changes in rules adopted by the bureau be adopted by the entire Legislature after the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and institutional services reviews them and recommends alterations.

This process is required by law which prohibits the Legislature from delegating its function to a committee.
