COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 367, L.D. 1086, Bill, "AN ACT to Bring Noncarbonated Beverages such as Fruit Punch and Iced Tea into Compliance with Maine's Beverage Container Law."

Amend the bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following: "Sec. 1."

Further  
/amend the bill in section 1, subsection 1, 4th line (3rd line in LD) by striking out the underlined words "fruit juice or milk product" and inserting in / place 'milk products'

Further amend the bill in section 1, subsection 2 by striking out in the last  $\left\langle \text{-----} \right\rangle$  2 lines (same in LD) the underlined words and figure "18 liquid ounces or less of nonalcoholic noncarbonated drink, except fruit juice or milk products" and inserting in / place the underlined words and figure '12/ounces, <sup>their</sup> liquid of nonalcoholic noncarbonated drink'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

This amendment  $\left\langle \text{-----} \right\rangle$  includes 12-ounce containers of nonalcoholic noncarbonated beverages under the beverage container law.
