STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Covering Cost-of-Living Increases for Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1973, c. 224, § 3 is repealed.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1973, c. 224, § 4 is enacted to read:

Sec. 4. Cost-of-living adjustments. Beginning in 1981, adjustments in the retirement benefits for certain teachers provided herein shall be made annually in accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, except that in the year 1981, such increase or decrease shall be in November. This section applies to those teachers named in the private and special laws of 1971, chapter 144 and the private and special laws of 1973, chapter 140.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a cost-of-living increase for a small group of retired teachers who are presently not receiving that increase.
