the underlined word and punctuation 'general,'

Further amend the Amendment in the last 2 lines before the  
Statement of Fact by striking out the underlined words and figure  
"other than as provided by subsection 22"

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that employees or officials of  
federal, state or municipal governments in the course of their  
employment shall be considered commercial applicators in the  
case of general-use pesticides, as well as limited or restricted-
