STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to appropriate Funds, on a Local Matching Basis, for an Instrument Landing System at the Sanford Municipal Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF

Bureau of Aeronautics

Capital

\$125,000

For construction of an instrument landing system at Sanford Municipal Airport. Funds may be used only if an equal amount is available from local sources, otherwise the appropriation lapses to the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds, on a local matching basis, for an instrument landing system at the Sanford Municipal Airport.
