COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 947, L.D. 1123, Bill, "AN ACT to Eliminate the Disincentive for Aid to Families with Dependent Children Recipients to Find Employment."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Department of Human Services; Aid to Families with Dependent Children work incentive plan. The Department of Human Services shall submit for approval to any special legislative second session held prior to January 1, 1982, or to the / regular session of the 110th Legislature if no special session is held, a plan for the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program which provides maximum work incentive in the Aid to Families with Dependent Children grant calculation formula consistent with federal law and regulations. The plan shall ensure no reduction in grants to the Aid to Families with Dependent Children recipients with no outside income.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the bill to a private and special law directing the Department of Human Services to present to the Legislature a plan for providing maximum work incentive within the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program.
