HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 378,  
L.D. 1136, Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Certain Signs from the Bill-  
board Law."

Amend the amendment by inserting in the 3rd line from  
the end, before the statement of fact, after the underlined  
word "harvested" the underlined word 'primarily'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end,  
before the statement of fact, the following underlined sentence:  
'For the purposes of this paragraph, "seasonal" includes a reason-  
able period of time after harvest of an agricultural product during  
which that product is stored and kept for sale.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment has 2 purposes:

1. It permits farm stores exempted from the billboard law to  
sell, as an incidental part of their business, other agricultural  
products not raised or harvested on the premises; and
2. It ensures that "seasonal" includes a reasonable period  
of time after harvest during which produce is refrigerated and  
continued to be sold.
