STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

**AN ACT to Remove the Town of Osborn from the Maine Forestry District.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** 12 MRSA § 1201, 4th ¶, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1965, c. 226, § 34, is amended to read:

**Municipalities:** ~~Osborn Plantation Municipality~~: No. 33 Plantation.

**Sec. 2. Town of Osborn.** Any tax levied against the Town of Osborn under the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1601, since the organization of that town which remains unpaid is forgiven.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Town of Osborn to be removed from the Maine Forestry District. Section 2 recognizes that Osborn had intended by its organization into a town, to be removed from the Maine Forestry District and relieved of the forestry district tax. This will place the town in the position that it would have been but for this legislative oversight.
