STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Requiring Certain Price Information on Certificates of Title Applications and Certificates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 2364, sub-§ 2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. **New vehicles.** If the application refers to a new vehicle purchased from a dealer, it shall contain, in a suitable place indicated by the Secretary of State, the manufacturer's full or suggested list price and the price for any optional equipment.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 2367, sub-§ 1, ¶ F, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 586, § 1, is amended to read:

F. Any other data the Secretary of State, prescribes, including, in the case of a new vehicle purchased from a dealer, the manufacturer's full or suggested list price and the price for any optional equipment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that the manufacturer's full or suggested list price and the price for any optional equipment be included in a title application for a new vehicle purchased from a dealer. This would provide tax collectors with accurate and uniform information for excise tax purposes.
